

## ***Curriculum Coordinator Report:***

### ***Curriculum Work:***

#### ***Data:***

- The third and final iready diagnostics were completed by students. I reviewed the data including individual student, class, grade, and district growth and grade-level proficiency reports.
- I ready put out a comparative performance report showing grade level performance of students on the NYS and national levels. I created a chart that compares Harrisville students' results with students nationally and within the state.
- Our students' grade level placement in math is considerably higher than students at the national and state levels.
- Our students' grade level placement in ELA is slightly lower than students at the national and state levels.
- Preliminary results from the 3-8 math and ELA tests have been released. This data shows general performance levels on each question for all students who took the tests. It also includes the percentage of how the other students in our BOCES performed on the same questions. The data reveals that overall we saw considerable growth in our students' proficiency on the constructed response questions. In many cases, our scores were higher than the BOCES percentages. This is great news, since we have targeted this area, and the teachers have been working with students to improve in this area.
- Leigh Stark and I met with the high school teachers who are going to be teaching middle school next year and reviewed iready data, and the state test results. This will help them gauge where their new students are struggling and where they are already being successful. This will help with lesson planning and preparation. We will further be exploring the use of i ready and the state test, since the ELA and Math teachers will need to be familiar with both forms of assessment.

***Curriculum Alignment:***

- I have been planning for next year, seeking out and ordering resources and instructional materials for teachers and communicating with providers to make sure that teachers have what they need for the upcoming school year.
- 6-8 ELA teachers now have access to the Study Cync curriculum that is aligned with Open Court. They will be spending some time this summer preparing for their new classes, using this resource.

***Positive School Culture:***

- The end of the year brought many celebrations and events for all students. Parents, family, and friends seemed to enjoy all of the ceremonies and celebrations. The teachers and staff worked extremely hard to make all of these events memorable.
