The end of the 1<sup>st</sup> marking period is over and report cards will be going home with students at the end of this week. This will also coincide with Parent Conferences next week. We have asked staff to provide the names of the students who we really need to meet on with the parents and the Guidance Office has been busy scheduling these meetings. We have also started to train staff on Computer Based Testing (CBT) which will be initiated in January during our simulation time frame and then the "real" exams will be given in April and May (see attached schedule).

We have also been having initial conversation to discuss plans for the solar eclipse on Apr. 8<sup>th</sup>. Right now, we are talking about setting up various stations for our older students to "teach" our younger students are various aspects of space, the eclipse and astronomy as a whole. It should be a great learning experience for everyone!

In athletics, the girls' and boys' soccer seasons have completed with both teams losing hard fought battles in the first and second rounds. 4-6 basketball season also just finished up and both teams had very successful seasons with a lot of growth along the way.
