3.0 Public Participation – Mr. Paul Jackson discussed how Fire Departments are struggling to find recruits. He stated Harrisville Volunteer Fire Department currently has 30 fireman and with the increasing State mandates only 19 are certified. Law 466-A allows the Town, County and School Districts to offer a 10% tax break for certified firefighters. There is a requirement of a 2-year membership before the tax break would be effective. The Board thanked Mr. Jackson for the information and his time.

Mrs. Avallone congratulated Brian Coloney for receiving the distinction of Coach of the Year and Eric Luther for receiving Athletic Director of the year.

Ms. Marchione asked how home school students affect our budget. Mr. Finster stated we do not receive aid for those students who are homeschooled. She asked what is being done to increase enrollment for instance with Fort Drum. Mr. Finster stated that the video that Zach Ribert made has been sent to them showing them about Harrisville Central School.
