Efforts to promote reading:

- Easier access to age appropriate books We created an Early Chapter Book section in the elementary library to make it easier for students to find beginning chapter books when they are transitioning from picture books.
- Collaboration with ELA teachers Students in grades 8-12 came to the library to pick books for outside reading.
- **Promotion of SORA E-books and audiobooks-** Access information was shared with students across grade levels. This is available to students 24/7.
- Less strict loan limits/overdue policies to promote equity of access We continue to try to allow all of our students to sign out books even if they have overdue books.
- **Book ownership** Mrs. French gave students in grades PreK-5 a new paperback book to keep. The school also allowed all students in grades Prek-4 to pick a book from the book fair.
- **Summer Circulation/Summer Hours -** Students in grades 2 11 were able to sign books out for the summer. Approximately 150 books were signed out for the summer. The library will be open one morning a week during summer school for circulation.
- Dolly Parton Imagination Library HCS continues to be an official affiliate for this
 program. The program sends a book every month to children ages 0-5 at no cost to
 families.

Other Library Services:

- **Online DMV permit test** - Mrs. Theriault administered 28 permit tests. This allows students to take the test in a familiar, quiet environment.
