- Submit a letter of application to Mr. John Casserly, 513 Miner Street Road, Canton, NY 13617. The letter must be postmarked by <u>April 15. 2024</u>, to provide time for selection and notification to recipients and their schools in advance of graduation.
- The letter of application MUST include 1) a summary of the student's musical interests and involvement in any school and local community music activities
 a summary of the student's plans for further academic or trades education and training
 a description of any community service done by the student during their high school years.
- 3. With the letter of application, you must provide the items that follow:
 - A. A recommendation from your guidance office or music department or both.

B. A list of any acceptances to a college or a trades or apprentice school or program

C. A copy of your high school academic transcript.

Award recipients will be selected by the Goldenaires. Photos of the award recipients will be featured on the Goldenaires Facebook page and in some local publications.
